El Sagrado Corazón es la devoción al corazón físico de Jesucristo como un símbolo de amor divino. Es una metáfora del amor de Jesús por la humanidad.

El Sagrado Corazón se representa en el arte cristiano como un corazón en llamas que brilla con la luz divina. Está herido y rodeado de espinas. A veces esta imagen se muestra en la figura de Jesús. La imagen alude a la muerte de Jesús y el fuego representa el poder de transformación del amor divino.

La imagen del Sagrado Corazón es parte de la devoción al corazón humano de Jesús y con frecuencia se encuentra en las casas de los creyentes en un lugar de honor.

El 16 de junio de 1675, Santa Margarita María de Alacoque tuvo una visión de Jesús en la que él le mostró su corazón rodeado de llamas de amor, coronado de espinas y con una herida abierta. De la herida brotaba sangre y del interior del corazón salía una cruz. Santa Margarita María de Alacoque aprendió la devoción al Sagrado Corazón entre 1673 and 1675, cuando recibió varias visiones de Jesús. Jesús le dijo a Santa Margarita María de Alacoque que quienes oraran con devoción al Sagrado Corazón, recibirían muchas gracias, llamadas las promesas del Sagrado Corazón de Jesús.

En mayo de 1673, el Corazón de Jesús le dio a Santa Margarita María para aquellas almas devotas a su Corazón las siguientes promesas:

Les daré todas las gracias necesarias para su estado de vida.

Les daré paz a sus familias.

Las consolaré en todas sus penas.

Seré su refugio durante la vida y sobre todo a la hora de la muerte.

Derramaré abundantes bendiciones en todas sus empresas.

Los pecadores encontrarán en mi Corazón un océano de misericordia.

Las almas tibias se volverán fervorosas.

Las almas fervorosas harán rápidos progresos en la perfección.

Bendeciré las casas donde mi imagen sea expuesta y venerada.

Otorgaré a aquellos que se ocupan de la salvación de las almas el don de mover los corazones más endurecidos.

Grabaré para siempre en mi Corazón los nombres de aquellos que propaguen esta devoción.

Yo te prometo, en la excesiva misericordia de mi Corazón, que su amor omnipotente concederá a todos aquellos que comulguen nueve Primeros Viernes de mes seguidos, la gracia de la penitencia final: No morirán en desgracia mía, ni sin recibir sus Sacramentos, y mi Corazón divino será su refugio en aquél último momento.

A esta última promesa se le atribuye la costumbre católica de ir a misa y recibir la comunión los viernes.

## **VESTRY UPDATE**

The Vestry evaluated two bids to get the parking lot repaved and voted to accept the bid from Hicklin Asphalt. Bids are being collected to replace the projector in the Parish House and to update the church's security systems. Both will be discussed in further detail at the June meeting. The plumbing issues continue; we are waiting for the plumber to evaluate the situation and present a bid on getting it fixed. The accounting office has been moved upstairs, next to Sally's office; the new computer has been installed and the new financial officers have been trained. The bookstore is now open in its new location across from the choir room. Tshirts, cups, and other items bearing our logo have been ordered and will be in stock soon. Please tell Ruth Hartman thank you for all the work she has put into getting the bookstore set up. For the month of April, income vs expenses was down about \$2,600. We are reminded to stay current with our pledges during the summer months.
