From the Desk of The Rev. Joe Pierjok

There are three things that we have drilled into our heads that we are not to talk about in polite company: religion, politics, and money. Jesus, however, spends a lot of time talking about religion, politics (in the sense of how we order our lives as society), and money. I want to warn you right out of the gates that I'm about to talk about money. Before you shut down completely, please know that I won't be asking you for any money today. I reserve the right to ask you for money at another time. But today I will not be asking. Just talking. Talking about money has the capacity to make people feel very uncomfortable, especially in the context of their faith. And I understand that: we have all seen religious haggles who tell us that how we give is tied directly to how we're blessed. This is tender territory. However, I have a story that I want to begin to share with you, and I think that what you will find is that it is less of a story about money, and more about a love between God and God's people. In September of 2023 Grace held a stewardship kick-off breakfast. The goal was to educate folks on why giving to the church matters, why pledging is important for the church as an institution and as a ministry. We heard stories of what people love about Grace and why pledging, or tithing, is important for them. These stories helped us to understand that our monetary offering to God and to God's church have a real impact in our community and the lives of those who live and move within our community. The response felt like a positive one! At this same breakfast you were provided with a colorful page that showed about 12 different ways that Grace has made an impact on the world and church around us. Jesus tells us that "where our treasure is, there our hearts will be also," it is clear where Grace heart lies. It lies with Gods people, and in turn with God. Beloved, because of our faithful stewardship of Gods blessings in your life, Grace has continued to make a HUGE impact in our community. This year already Grace has given \$10,000 to St. Andrew's in Haiti so that their church could have a roof put on, \$1,047 to the Carthage Senior Center, \$1,000 to American Friends in the Diocese of Jerusalem to support their ongoing mission, \$558 to help mothers and young families have access to diapers through Happy Bottoms, \$10,000 has been given to support the training of new Episcopal clergy, and your support of the clergy's discretionary funds have continued to help folks who may be struggling paying bills, buying groceries, medications, cloths for job interviews, gas, etc. And it's only June! Beloved this generosity and aid is only made possible through our faithful devotion of God. We are each called to offer to God the fruits of our labors, made possible by His love, to express our deep thanks. God in return takes, blesses, and then returns what is offered. The Church, YOU, are the hands that return these blessings to the world! It is important to remember that above all else the life, work, and very being of the Church are all rooted in the profound love of God. This is your story Grace, a story of LOVE.
